SUBJECT: **EXTENDING THE INCENTIVES SYSTEM FOR MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL**

**Pursuant to BR No. 2023-32**, and in reference to the Incentives System adopted by IECEP, Inc.: The Members of the Advisory Council, in acknowledgment of the meritorious service rendered to advance the profession, through dedicated leadership at the Institute, in the National Office, are hereby identified to be eligible to avail of the following benefit:

### WAIVED REGISTRATION FOR INSTITUTIONAL EVENTS

Under the IECEP Constitution and By-Laws Article XII : The **ADVISORY COUNCIL** is composed of **ALL PAST PRESIDENTS OF THE INSTITUTE**, and **INCUMBENT MEMBERS OF THE PROFESSIONAL REGULATORY BOARD OF ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING**.

Financial incentives equivalent to one hundred percent (100%) for participation in institutional events (convention proper) shall be extended to the Advisory Council.

Stakeholders as specified above shall produce a Certificate of Appointment as proof of their designation, for the purpose of availing the discount or refund for transactions related to membership and registration.

It is clarified that the Certification shall be exclusively issued by the National Office. Lost, stolen, damaged documents may be requested from the National Secretariat, subject to existing guidelines.

Supplementary guidelines may be promulgated by the MODCC and Finance Committee for the effective implementation of this Order.

These shall be valid immediately and only from the date first specified, and shall remain in-force until superseded. This is to be posted in IECEP's Medium of General Circulation.
