The national Cybersecurity Month campaign, according to the measure, was moved to October to synchronize with the international observance of the event and to further signify the country's unwavering commitment towards a unified approach in the digital era of governance and to reinforce efforts to address strategic policy dimensions of cybersecurity, develop a national cyber defense capability, and create public awareness through intensified campaigns showcasing cybersecurity information

IECEP, being an organization with professionals whose scope of practice of profession according to Republic Act No. 9292 include Computer and ICT specialization as well as the Cybersecurity Specialization as endorsed on Board Resolution 2023-049, plays a very vital role on the conduct of ICT and Cybersecurity in the country and should have a significant role on this campaign.

As such, all Chapters along with the respective Societies are hereby enjoined to spearhead programs and activities related to Cybersecurity for the whole month of October. Coordinations, collaborations and visits to related government agencies such as the Department of Information and Communications Technology and other stakeholder allied organizations are very much encouraged.
