Board Resolution No.: 2022 - 003

REINSTATEMENT OF COLLECTION OF AFFILIATION FEE FOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS AFFILIATED WITH IECEP INC

WHEREAS, IECEP, Inc through the Education and Student Affairs Committee (ESAC), as; lifted from the Articles of Incorporation (Aol) shall (a) promote fellowship, free exchange of ideas, and mutual help and respect among the members of the profession; (b) provide leadership and guidance to young professionals, and inspiration to students in the profession; and (c) discover and encourage the outstanding talent among the youths of our land who can contribute to the advancement of the profession;

WHEREAS, Article VI Section 8 of the Aol defines an Institutional Member to include "...school, college, institute or university of recognized standing offering a regular course in electronics engineering...;"

WHEREAS, Article VI Section 9 (h) of the Aol provides that "Nomination to the Institutional Membership Category shall be by invitation as approved by the majority of the Board of Directors;"

WHEREAS, the Institute, through its Chapters, has historically collected One Thousand Pesos (PhP 1,000.00) as Institutional Membership Fee for Higher Education Institutions Affiliated with IECEP Inc, also commonly known as Affiliation Fee;

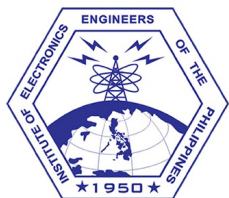
WHEREAS, payment of the Institutional Membership / Affiliation Fees allows students of affiliated HEIs to join ESAC and Chapter activities such as, but not limited to seminars/webinars, trainings, conferences, colloquium, fora and student competitions, among others,

WHEREAS, in 2020, collection of the subject fees were temporarily waived due to the economic effects of the pandemic;

WHEREAS, Article III Section 3b of the Aol states that "The National Headquarters governed by the Board of Directors shall be the overall policy-making body of the Institute with the President as the Chief Executive. Among others, it shall have the following powers overall chapters and regional directorates; (b) Fix membership dues and incidental fees;"

WHEREAS, Article X Section 1 of the AOI further provides that "The Board of Directors shall prescribe membership fees per category and has the power to adjust or revise them as the need arises."

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the Affiliation Fee in the amount of One Thousand Pesos (PhP 1,000.00) be charged to HEIs and that collections shall reinstated beginning 14 February 2022, for the widest dissemination for all concerned through the Publications Committee;
