RESOLUTION NO. 2022-028

CHAPTER ACCREDITATION AND APPROVAL OF IECEP AMERICAS

WHEREAS, Article 3, Section 3 of the IECEP, Inc. Constitution and By-Laws states the following : "The National Headquarters governed by the Board of Directors shall be the overall policymaking of the Institute.... Among others, it shall have the following powers over all chapters and regional directorates : Approve applications for membership in the Institute and Establish policies, rules and regulations in accordance with the IECEP By-Laws.."

WHEREAS, Article 3, Section 6 of the IECEP, Inc. Constitution and By-Laws states the following: "Foreign-based chapters may be organized and given due recognition by the National Headquarters In cities of any country.."

WHEREAS, a group of twelve (12) engineers led by Engr. June Lloyd Emerson R. Gopela, IECEP UAE Chapter Vice-Governor for Internal Affairs and an IECEP Outstanding ECE Awardee for 2021, last August 21, 2022, submitted its application and documents to establish IECEP Americas, a foreign-based chapter with jurisdictions covering the countries in the Northern America and Southern America;

WHEREAS, IECEP, Inc., and its Memberships, Organizational Development and Chapters Committee (MODCC) recommended for the accreditation and approval of IECEP Americas as it satisfactorily completed all of the necessary requirements to establish a Foreign Chapter;

NOW, THEREFORE RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that IECEP Americas Chapter shall be officially approved as a new IECEP Foreign Chapter with IECEP Chapter Accreditation Number Fifty-One (51).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that IECEP Americas Chapter shall thereafter complete all necessary compliances required by IECEP Inc. prior to its operations as a Foreign Chapter subject to the guidance of various IECEP Committees such as the Memberships, Organizational Development and Chapters Committee (MODCC), Finance Committee, Education and Student Affairs Committee (ESAC) and Publications Committee.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that IECEP Americas shall be included in the Chapter Jurisdiction Matrix published at our Official Website.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this resolution be published in the Official Website and furnished to all Accredited Chapters and the General Membership for guidance and reference of all concerned; and that these shall be effective immediately upon the release of this resolution.
