RESOLUTION NO. 2022-030

EXTENDING THE INCENTIVES SYSTEM FOR ELECTRONICS ENGINEERS AND ELECTRONICS TECHNICIANS BOARD TOPNOTCHERS

WHEREAS, Article VI of the Constitution and By-Laws (CBL) of IECEP, Inc. defines the grades of membership of the Institute, including Honorary, Fellow, Charter, Life, Member, Associate, Affiliate, Institutional and Student, with the respective qualifications as may be required for conferment;

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 1 of the CBL empowers the Board of Directors (BoD) to prescribe the appropriate membership fees per category, and to revise and adjust them as the need arises;

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 3b of the CBL states that "The National Headquarters governed by the Board of Directors shall be the overall policy-making body of the Institute with the President as the Chief Executive. Among others, it shall have the following powers overall chapters and regional directorates; (b) fix membership dues and incidental fees";

WHEREAS, the membership grades defined adds value to the organizational membership as it reflects career and professional development, credibility and stature, and shows a certain level of expertise reached in accordance to the practice of the profession;

WHEREAS, IECEP, Inc, recognizes the exemplary performance of Topnotchers on Electronics Engineering and Electronics Technician Board Exams;

NOW, THEREFORE RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, on motion duly seconded and unanimously approved, that in acknowledgement of the outstanding performance in the Board Examinations for Electronics Engineers and Electronics Technicians, Topnotchers are hereby identified to be eligible to avail of the benefits as provided under IECEP's Incentive system and as defined in the Guidelines below; and that the Membership, Organizational Development and Chapters Committee (MODCC) and Finance Committee of the Institute be empowered to prescribed additional admission guidelines as appropriate and necessary;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this resolution be published in the Official Website and furnished to all Accredited Chapters and the General Membership for guidance and reference of all concerned; and that these shall be effective immediately upon the release of this resolution, and shall remain inforce until superseded.

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INCENTIVES SYSTEM GUIDELINES FOR BOARD TOPNOTCHERS:

This has reference to the Incentives System adopted by IECEP, Inc.

In acknowledgment of the outstanding performance in the Board Examinations for Electronics Engineers and Electronics Technicians, topnotchers are hereby identified to be eligible to avail of the benefits as provided by IECEP's incentives system:

- A. Top 1-3, ECE Board
 - 100% Waiver of Initial Regular Membership Registration
- B. Top 4-10, ECE Board
 - 50% Incentive for Initial Regular Membership Registration
- C. Top 1-3, ECT Board
 - 100% Waiver of Initial Associate Membership Registration
- D. Top 4-10, ECT Board
 - 50% Incentive for Initial Associate Membership Registration

In cases when a topnotcher places both in ECE and ECT, the higher of the incentives shall prevail, in accordance with the single membership grade policy.

Thereafter, financial incentives equivalent to ten percent (10%) shall be applicable for membership renewals to IECEP (on his/her first renewal cycle ONLY) and participation in institutional events and engagements (for a period of three (3) years).

All other requirements and processes provided in related Orders shall remain in force, however, in lieu of presenting an ID, stakeholders as specified above shall produce a PRC Rating Certificate as proof of their being a board topnotcher, for the purpose of availing the discount or refund for transactions related to membership and registration.

Further, provisions on the standard exclusions shall apply, i.e. not applicable for already discounted rates, limited/promotional offers, and back-dues/arrears, among others, and in effect, all prohibitions cited in related issuances shall likewise extend to the above-mentioned stakeholder groups.
