**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-031**

**EXTENDING THE INCENTIVES SYSTEM FOR IDENTIFIED STAKEHOLDER GROUPS**

**WHEREAS**, Article X, Section 1 of the CBL empowers the Board of Directors (BoD) to prescribe the appropriate membership fees per category, and to revise and adjust them as the need arises;

**WHEREAS**, Article III, Section 3b of the CBL states that "The National Headquarters governed by the Board of Directors shall be the overall policy-making body of the Institute with the President as the Chief Executive. Among others, it shall have the following powers overall chapters and regional directorates; (b) fix membership dues and incidental fees";

**WHEREAS**, IECEP, Inc, adopted the Incentives System for various groups such as Senior Citizens, Persons with Disability, Solo Parents, and Board Topnotchers among others;

**WHEREAS**, IECEP, Inc, recognizes the meritorious service rendered by IECEP Leaders to advance the cause of the profession and the organization;

**NOW, THEREFORE RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, on motion duly seconded and unanimously approved, that in acknowledgement of the meritorious service and leadership of the following stakeholder groups : Former National Board of Directors, Incumbent and Former Chapter Governors, Incumbent Chapter Officers and Trustees, Incumbent Chair and Members for National Committees, and Incumbent Society Board of Directors; these stakeholder groups are hereby identified to be eligible to avail of the benefits as provided under IECEP's Incentive system and as defined in the Guidelines below; and that the Membership, Organizational Development and Chapters Committee (MODCC) and Finance Committee of the Institute be empowered to prescribed additional admission guidelines as appropriate and necessary;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that this resolution be published in the Official Website and furnished to all Accredited Chapters and the General Membership for guidance and reference of all concerned; and that these shall be effective immediately upon the release of this resolution, and shall remain inforce until superseded.

## INCENTIVES SYSTEM GUIDELINES FOR IDENTIFIED STAKEHOLDER GROUPS:

This has reference to the Incentives System adopted by IECEP, Inc.

In acknowledgment of the meritorious service rendered to advance the profession and the organization, through dedicated leadership at the Institute, in the National Office, National Committees, Duly-Accredited Chapters and Duly-Accredited Specialization Societies, the following stakeholder groups are hereby identified to be eligible to avail of the benefits as provided by IECEP's incentives system:

- A. Former **National Board of Directors**
- B. Incumbent and Former **Chapter Governors**
- C. Incumbent **Chapter Officers and Trustees**
- D. Incumbent **Chair and Members**, National Committees
- E. Incumbent Specialization **Societies Board of Directors**, Specialization Societies

Financial incentives equivalent to ten percent (10%) shall be applicable for membership renewals to IECEP and participation in institutional events and engagements, unless otherwise specified.

For stakeholder group (C), membership renewal shall coincide with their term of office; on participation fees, Chapters shall have updated remittance on the latest period prior to the engagement and shall be compliant to the various Resolutions, Orders and Memorandums in effect including those related to General Membership Administration, Finance Administration and Membership/CPD Portal Administration. Also, only those OFFICIALLY and DULY REPORTED OFFICERS and TRUSTEES of the Chapter to the National Office shall be eligible.

For stakeholder (D), this includes both standing and special committees; only for Institutional events.

For stakeholder (E), only duly accredited specialization societies are considered; only for Institutional events.

All other requirements and processes provided in related Resolutions and Orders, shall remain in force, however, in lieu of presenting an ID, stakeholders as specified above shall produce a Certificate of Appointment as proof of their designation, for the purpose of availing the discount or refund for transactions related to membership and registration.

It is clarified that the Certification shall be exclusively issued by the National Office. Lost, stolen, damaged documents may be requested from the National Secretariat, subject to existing guidelines.

Further, provisions on the standard exclusions shall apply, i.e. not applicable for already discounted rates, limited/promotional offers, and back-dues/arrears, among others, and in effect, all prohibitions cited for the Senior Citizens, Persons With Disability, and Solo Parents in related issuances shall likewise extend to the above-mentioned stakeholder groups.
