RESOLUTION NO. 2022-006

ACCREDITATION PROCESS FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE IECEP NATIONAL SPECIALIZATION SOCIETIES FOR EACH SPECIALIZATION

WHEREAS, IECEP, Inc., aims to give accreditation to the National Specialization Societies to ascertain recognition as the sole and legitimate Society for each field of specialization endorsed by the National Board as defined on Board Resolution Number 2021-013;

WHEREAS, the Career Progression and Specialization Program (CPSP) Rule Book for Electronics Engineering National Specialization Societies as defined on Board Resolution Number 2021-013 shall be the main reference for policies and guidelines pertaining to the operations of the National Specialization Societies under IECEP, Inc.;

WHEREAS, the National Specialization Society applying for accreditation on each specialization shall be able to satisfy the requirements of IECEP, Inc. through the recommendation of the National Specializations Committee;

WHEREAS, the minimum requirements for accreditation of a National Specialization Society shall include the following:

- To create a preliminary roster of ECT, ECE and PECEs in its Specialization Society
- To develop a Competency Matrix system designed for all interested Electronics Engineering Professionals which shall be used to evaluate and confer Specialists or Level 8 Professional Certification at the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC)
- To be able to craft a roadmap that will prove the operational and functional existence of the Society including activities for the development and enhancement of its Society Members

WHEREAS, the Specializations Committee shall coordinate with the Finance Committee for the smooth implementation of this resolution and appropriation of funds for approved engagements, fund requests and external linkages subject to adherence to the Institute's existing policies and guidelines thereafter;

NOW, THEREFORE RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the Accreditation for each of the National Specialization Societies shall be given ONLY for those who submitted their formal application and upon the approval of their application addressed to the National Board through the recommendation of the Specializations Committee;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Specializations Committee of the Institute shall be empowered to prescribe and create the implementing guidelines as appropriate and necessary;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that these standardized processes and corresponding guidelines be published in the Official Website and furnished to Accredited Chapters and the National Specialization Societies for guidance and reference of all concerned; and that these shall be effective immediately upon the release of this resolution and implementing guidelines.
