#### RESOLUTION NO. 2022-020

#### CHAPTER NOMENCLATURE AND JURISDICTION FOR NCR CHAPTERS

**WHEREAS**, Article 2, Section 2 of the IECEP, Inc. Constitution and By-Laws states the following : "Membership in the Institute shall be through the Local Chapters or Foreign-Based Chapters... In case there is no existing chapter in a Member's domicile, he can join the chapter of his choice nearest his residence or place of work.. ";

**WHEREAS**, Article 3, Section 3 and Section 3.e of the IECEP, Inc. Constitution and By-Laws states the following : "The National Headquarters governed by the Board of Directors shall be the overall policymaking body of the Institute.... Among others, it shall have the following powers over all chapters.... Establish policies, rules and regulations in accordance with the IECEP By-Laws.;"

**WHEREAS**, IECEP, Inc., in its Memorandum dated January 17, 2012 issued by then IECEP National President, Engr. Teodoro Buenavista Jr., states that the National Capital Region or Metro Manila was divided into four districts following the Philippine National Police Districts. As such, Western and Southern Districts were handled by IECEP Manila Chapter while the Northern and Eastern Districts were handled by IECEP Quezon City Chapter;

**WHEREAS**, IECEP, Inc., aims to provide further directions on the Nomenclature and Jurisdiction of existing IECEP Chapters to facilitate more responsive Chapter operations and for the general membership to be further guided on his Chapter Association;

**WHEREAS**, IECEP, Inc., adopted the recommendation of the Memberships, Organizational Development and Chapters Committee (MODCC), with regards to the Nomenclature for IECEP NCR or Metro Manila Chapters in response to the request of IECEP Quezon City Chapter and IECEP Manila Chapter to look into the issue of NCR Chapter Nomenclature;

**NOW, THEREFORE RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, that IECEP Chapters shall be named using any of the following choices : the country/ies name or combination thereof (for Foreign Chapters); the Region Name; a combination of the Provinces comprising the Region; the Province Name, the City/Municipality Name or Combination thereof, or an acceptable and well-defined name which constitutes immediate identification of the place and location of the Chapter being identified.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that in the spirit of solidarity, IECEP Quezon City Chapter shall now be recognized as IECEP NCR North-East Chapter, while IECEP Manila Chapter shall retain IECEP Manila Chapter (as the City of Manila is the Capital of NCR and in itself is widely recognized to represent the totality of the Region) or adopt IECEP NCR South-West Chapter as an option. IECEP Manila Chapter shall formally express its choice in the form of writing addressed to the IECEP National Board of Directors through the Memberships, Organizational Development and Chapters Committee (MODCC) within 15 days from the released of this resolution.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that a Chapter Jurisdiction Matrix shall be published at our Official Website where the general membership can look-up its place of residence or work and identify thereafter his Chapter of Association.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the IECEP NCR Chapters Jurisdiction as defined on the IECEP National Board Memorandum dated January 17, 2012 shall be retained and shall remain as is;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that separate guidelines and procedures for Chapter Accreditation, Chapter Amendments and Chapter Revocation of Accreditation be published in relation to this resolution;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that this resolution be published in the Official Website and furnished to all Accredited Chapters and the General Membership for guidance and reference of all concerned; and that these shall be effective immediately upon the release of this resolution.
