**WHEREAS**, the Institute of Electronics Engineers of the Philippines, Incorporated (IECEP) is a duly registered organization with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and Accredited Integrated Professional Organization by the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC);

**WHEREAS**, the Commission on Filipinos Overseas (CFO) is an agency of the government of the Philippines under the Office of the President of the Philippines responsible for promoting and upholding the interest of Filipino emigrants and Filipino permanent residents in other countries and preserving and strengthening ties with Filipino communities outside the Philippines;

**WHEREAS**, The Institute of Electronics Engineers of the Philippines (IECEP) has recently formed a partnership with the Commission on Filipinos Overseas (CFO), with the aim of promoting the welfare of Filipino Electronics Professionals and Practitioners abroad and contributing to Nation Building;

**WHEREAS**, the Memorandum of Agreement was signed during IECEP's Mid-Year Convention in Davao in year 2022;
