WHEREAS, as part of the agreement the CFO will provide and host a website for IECEP's Foreign Chapters and will be manage by IECEP;

WHEREAS, IECEP and CFO will collaborate and support the different programs and projects offered by both parties

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreement was signed during IECEP's Mid-Year Convention in Davao in year 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of The Institute of Electronics Engineers of the Philippines (IECEP) hereby approves the partnership agreement between IECEP and the Commission on Filipinos Overseas (CFO), effective 02 June 2022;
