SUBJECT: **SUPPLEMENTAL GUIDELINES FOR INSTITUTIONAL MEMBERS AND PARTNERS**

DATE: **21 FEBRUARY 2023**

**WHEREAS**, the Institute of Electronics Engineers of the Philippines (IECEP), Incorporated is a duly registered organization with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and Accredited Integrated Professional Organization by the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC);

**WHEREAS**, the Institute recognizes the importance of institutional memberships and partnerships in strengthening the organization's programs and activities;

**WHEREAS**, the Institute has formulated guidelines on institutional memberships and partnerships as specified in Board Resolution 2022-019;

**WHEREAS**, the National Office will take charge of those firms/organizations or related companies who are entering into Institutional Memberships or Partnerships based on the guidelines;

**WHEREAS**, the 2023 Vice President for Internal Affairs Ira V. Estropia and MODCC recognizes the need for a supplemental guidelines for Board Resolution 2022-019;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Directors approves the implementation of the supplemental Guidelines on Institutional Memberships and Partnerships;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the Institutional Membership is divided into three main categories: Corporate/Industry, Academic/Higher Education Institutions (HEIs), and Non-Profit Organizations;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the National Office shall encourage industries and organizations both private and public related to the Electronics Engineering profession to be part of the organization through a Memorandum of Agreement or Memorandum of Understanding sealed under the Membership or Partnership;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that Institutional Partners are defined as an entity that provides facilities, equipment, resources, scholarships, and financial support to the organization with mutual benefits between IECEP and the Partner while not categorized as an Institutional Member, while Institutional Members are defined as per the definitions on the IECEP Constitution and By-Laws and as an entity that provides financial support to the organization through its Membership Dues;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that National Specialization/Specialty Societies (NSS) and Chapters may refer a person, firm, industries or organizations to become institutional members, and the NSS and Chapters will be entitled to 10% as an earmarked budget for the society or chapter in support to their activities, training, and workshops;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the primary objective of the National Specialization/Specialty Societies (NSS) is to produce Level 8 Specialists (and accomplish the tasks and objectives to produce such) and that these shall only be supplementary to the Society;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that there is no limit to the number of industries or firms that any society or chapter will refer to the National as an Institutional Member;
