SUBJECT: **FINAL ENDORSEMENT OF IECEP INC. FOR ADOPTION OF THE PROPOSED CCTV CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES TO THE PROFESSIONAL REGULATION COMMISSION INCLUDING REVISIONS MADE THEREOF DURING THE CONCLUDED CONSULTATION PROCESS**

DATE **21 MARCH 2023**

WHEREAS, the Institute of Electronics Engineers of the Philippines (IECEP), Incorporated is a duly registered organization with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and Accredited Integrated Professional Organization of Electronics Engineering Professionals by the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC);

WHEREAS, the practice of Surveillance Systems/CCTV Systems/Premises Security Systems is under the Electronics Engineering Profession as defined on related laws such R.A. 9292 and its IRR, P.D. 1096 and its IRR et. Al;

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 2e of the IECEP Constitution and By-laws expounds the duties and functions of the Engineering Code Committee which includes, "conduct research work and technical studies for the purpose of developing new or changes to or upgrades of the Engineering Code/s relative to the practice of the Electronics Engineering Profession";

WHEREAS, Rule 2, Section 7l of the IRR of the Republic Act 9292, under the Powers and Functions of the Professional Regulatory Board of Electronics Engineering states that they have the power and function to "adopt and administer a code of ethics and a code of technical standards of practice for PECEs, ECEs, and ECTs in accordance with the scope and nature of practice defined under section 5, article I of RA9292";

WHEREAS, Rule 2, Section 7p of the IRR of the Republic Act 9292, under the Powers and Functions of the Professional Regulatory Board of Electronics Engineering states that they have the power and function to "formulate, prescribe, and adopt such rules and regulations for electronics installations in industrial plants, commercial establishments and other buildings or structures covered by the National Building code of the Philippines, in coordination with the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), other concerned agencies, representatives of industry and the Accredited Professional Organization";

WHEREAS, the Institute promulgated Board Resolution 2020-017, the Endorsement of Proposed ECE CCTV Code Draft to PRC-BECE;

WHEREAS, the Proposed CCTV Code of the Philippines duly endorsed by IECEP, Inc. through the Engineering Code Committee last 2020 to the Professional Regulation Commission has undergone a virtual public consultation led by the Professional Regulatory Board of Electronics Engineering last November 28, 2020 on the occasion of the IECEP Inc.'s e-AGM 2020;

WHEREAS, the Professional Regulatory Board of Electronics Engineering has further endorsed the Proposed CCTV Code of the Philippines to relevant Government agencies which include the National Telecommunications Commission and the Department of Information and Communications Technology as agencies directly involved in the development of standards related to such technologies;

WHEREAS, the proposed minor revisions from the various consultations have been forwarded to the IECEP, Inc. for consideration of its inclusion to the endorsed version of the Institute;
