SUBJECT: **IECEP ACADEMY PROGRAM**

DATE: **30 MAY 2023**

WHEREAS, the Institute of Electronics Engineers of the Philippines (IECEP), Incorporated is a duly registered organization with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and Accredited Integrated Professional Organization of Electronics Engineering Professionals by the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC);

WHEREAS, the IECEP ACADEMY form part of the 2023 IECEP "Next Level" Organizational Agenda of the National President;

WHEREAS, the IECEP ACADEMY will provide advancement for Electronics Professionals in terms of specialization aligning the programs of IECEP to Republic Act No. 10968 or the Philippine Qualifications Framework (PQF);

WHEREAS, the IECEP ACADEMY will augment the training and learning needs of the IECEP National Specialty Societies (NSS) in relation to the ECE Career Progression and Specialization Program (CPSP) and shall be the ONLY authorized program provider of IECEP for LEVEL 8 Specialization of the Electronics Engineering Profession;

WHEREAS, the IECEP ACADEMY will aim to provide consolidated and standardized training for Electronics Professionals including Technical and Soft Skills;

WHEREAS, the IECEP ACADEMY will consists of Face-to-Face, Virtual and Video-on-Demand Trainings in collaboration with different stakeholders, institutional partners, and educational institutions;

WHEREAS, the development of IECEP Academy infrastructure, website, and trainings encompassing both hard and soft skills is in progress;

WHEREAS, the IECEP Academy shall be utilized by the Chapters, Societies, and Committees for highly specialized trainings for Electronics Engineering and related Fields;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, Now, therefore, be it resolved that:

1. The Board approves the creation of IECEP Academy, which aims to provide high-quality trainings in both hard and soft skills to professionals in the industry.
2. The Board acknowledges the need for a robust infrastructure and user-friendly website to support the operations and accessibility of IECEP Academy.

4. IECEP Academy shall establish a dedicated website that serves as a comprehensive platform for accessing course information, registration, learning materials, and other relevant resources.
5. Trainings offered by IECEP Academy shall be CPD-accredited, ensuring that professionals can earn CPD points to fulfill their continuing education requirements.
6. IECEP Academy shall work closely with relevant accrediting bodies to obtain and maintain CPD accreditation for the trainings offered, adhering to the standards and guidelines set forth by such bodies.
