SUBJECT: **IECEP CRITERIA FOR PRC'S OUTSTANDING PROFESSIONAL OF THE YEAR AWARD (OPYA) NOMINEES**

DATE **26 JUNE 2023**

WHEREAS, the Institute of Electronics Engineers of the Philippines (IECEP), Incorporated is a duly registered organization with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and Accredited Integrated Professional Organization of Electronics Engineering Professionals by the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC);

WHEREAS, the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) has opened nominations for the Outstanding Professional of the Year Award (OPYA) 2023, which recognizes individuals who have made significant contributions to their respective professions;

WHEREAS, IECEP Inc. received PRC resolution 1625 series of 2023 that includes the minimum qualification to be nominated for the OPYA 2023;

WHEREAS, IECEP Inc. Board of Directors adopted the criteria set on resolution 1625 series of 2023 and approved the inclusion that IECEP's OPYA nominees shall already received an award as IECEP's Outstanding Electronics Engineer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that, the following criteria will be the reference to be among the shortlisted nominees for PRC's Outstanding Professional of the Year Award:

1. Filipino Citizen
2. Possesses a valid and current Professional Identification Card (PIC)
3. Exhibits good moral character and is a member in good standing of the [APO/AIPO]
4. Has not been found guilty in an administrative case by a final and executor decision rendered by a Professional Regulatory Board, the PRC, or other tribunals, or courts of competent jurisdiction.
5. Has not been convicted by final judgment by a court of competent jurisdiction of any crime involving moral turpitude.
6. Has not held any officer or director position in the national organization and chapters of [APO/AIPO] for at least one (1) year prior to the nomination for the awards.
7. Is not an incumbent Professional Regulatory Board, CPD Council, CPSP-CATS Committee member, or an official or employee of the Commission
8. Has not been previously awarded by the PRC, except in the case of another profession in which he/she is also licensed and registered.
9. Has previously been recognized and awarded as an Outstanding Electronics Engineer of IECEP.
