SUBJECT: **EXECUTIVE AMNESTY PROGRAM**

DATE: **23 OCTOBER 2023**

WHEREAS, the Institute of Electronics Engineers of the Philippines, Incorporated (IECEP) is a duly registered organization with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and Accredited Integrated Professional Organization of Electronics Professionals by the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC);

WHEREAS, IECEP, aside from being the AIPO of PECE, ECE and ECT, is the home of the Electronics Engineering Professionals;

WHEREAS, as part of the enhanced external affairs and corporate relations of the Institute in accordance to the IECEP "Next Level" organizational agenda, interaction with industry, government and academe have highlighted key personalities who have been pursuing efforts in the interest of the development of the electronics engineering fields of practice;

WHEREAS, in view of various campaigns to regain the interest on membership, IECEP has identified key personalities with BS ECE degrees who have not been in touch with the Institute nor have applied for government licensing;

WHEREAS, the accomplishments and contributions of identified individuals to the whole electronics engineering profession could not be discounted, let alone just be cancelled by the fact that for whatever reason, they have opted not to engage with IECEP nor the PRC;

WHEREAS, to promote a healthier perspective on inviting these accomplished personalities, who may likewise offer direct or indirect benefits to IECEP in their personal or official capacity, an executive amnesty program is envisaged;

RESOLVED, as it is **HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the National Board of Directors, be accorded two (2) slots per calendar year, for the on-boarding of identified personalities, who may be duly endorsed to the MODCC, as an organizational resource and asset, who may likewise be a prime example of a practicing electronics professional, under the Executive Amnesty Program (EAP);

RESOLVED FURTHER, that implementation of the EAP shall be supervised by the MODCC in close collaboration with the CAERC, under the purview of the Vice President for Internal Affairs and the Vice President for External Affairs respectively, who may jointly approve promulgated rules to ensure that the slots are optimized in alignment to the overall mission, vision, goals and objectives of IECEP.

- Option to Upgrade to Life Membership, based on prevailing policies and rates (and appropriate discounts)

- Barred from IECEP/PRC Awards for a Period of 3 Years
